## **Essential functions** of this position include:

- Rehearse at least weekly with the Chancel Choir throughout the year, subject to both a reduced "summer schedule" and potentially an increased schedule in advance of holiday and special performances
- Rehearse with and accompany the Handbell, Children's, and Youth choirs as needed
- Perform music for memorial services or work with the Director of Music to arrange substitutes when necessary
- Meet and collaborate with the Director of Music as needed
- Secure substitute organists as necessary to cover paid time off, in collaboration with the Director of Music

- Bachelor's degree in music or related field preferred (equivalent experience will be considered)

  Note: Finalists will be asked to audition in person before a candidate is selected
- Keyboarding proficiency on the organ and piano, specifically in sacred music
- Experience accompanying choral performances, solo voice and instrumental works
- Knowledge of sacred keyboard repertoire suitable for use in worship
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team environment

Understands theological principles behind sacred music, committed to their own faith, and comfortable performing with faith-based principles
